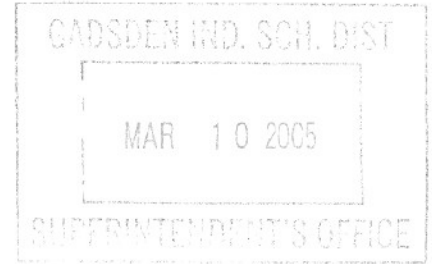

Dear Superintendent Haugen:

Thank you for your recent letter requesting a reorganization, following Regulation 6.30.2.10.F. NMAC, of Anthony Elementary School and Loma Linda Intermediate School. The request is to change grade levels at these schools as follows:

Anthony Elementary, from K-3 to K-6, and
Loma Linda Intermediate, from 4-6 to Loma Linda Elementary K-6.

Staff in the School Budget and Finance Analysis Bureau state that these membership changes will not generate size adjustment units. Staff in the Pupil Transportation Bureau state that these changes do not appear to have any impact on the current level of transportation regarding equipment.

Based on the information provided and a positive recommendation from my staff, I do approve this reorganization request to be implemented beginning with the 2005-2006 school year.
