

TAKE CONTROL OF YOUR ENERGY USE with the New Mexico Gas SCORESM Pilot Program

The SCORE Pilot Program offers financial incentives (\$0.75/therm) along with technical and consulting assistance to help schools identify, compare and implement energy efficiency projects. From the installation of no cost natural gas saving products to incentives for larger, more complex equipment and projects, the program provides the necessary resources to make immediate and sustainable reductions in energy use and spending.

SCHOOLS





SCORE Pilot program technicians will install no-cost natural gas and water-saving measures as appropriate based on your existing equipment. Items commonly include high-efficiency spray valves, faucet aerators and showerheads. Together, these measures can save you hundreds of dollars per year in gas and water costs. Best of all, they're available at no cost to you!

INCENTIVES FOR CUSTOMIZED ENERGY SOLUTIONS



Beyond the no-cost measures, the program offers \$0.75/therm toward other equipment types and processes to save energy. Depending on the facility type and operating characteristics, eligible measure may include:

- · Boiler retrofits and improvements
- Infrared heating
- · Demand controlled ventilation
- · Roof and ceiling insulation
- · Swimming pool covers
- And other natural gas-related equipment and processes

COMMERCIAL KITCHENS



Food preparation accounts for 35 percent of a commercial kitchen's energy use, but much of that is lost due to inefficient appliances. In fact, commercial kitchens use about 2.5 times more energy per square foot than other commercial buildings. New Mexico Gas offers rebates for energy efficiency measures that reduce such energy use, including:

- \$720 for ENERGY STAR® Gas Convection Ovens
- \$500 for ENERGY STAR Gas Fryers
- \$300 for ENERGY STAR Dish Washers
- \$225 for ENERGY STAR Gas Griddles

STEPS TO PARTICIPATE

- 2. Sign and submit the Participation Agreement below.
- 3. Work with the Program Administrator to formally identify energy efficiency project opportunities, quantify prospective energy savings, and reserve NM Gas Co. incentives.
- 4. Schedule your assessment, implementation, and post-project completion inspections.
- 5. Receive incentive dollars from NM Gas Co. and benefit from future years of saving natural gas and money.

PARTICIPATION AGREEMENT

This Program Participation Agreement reflects the **voluntary collaboration** between your organization and the SCORE Pilot Program and details the commitments of each party in order to improve energy efficiency in your facilities. *The Program agrees to provide services to the Participant with the understanding that the Participant will exert its best efforts to implement cost-effective energy efficiency recommendations. Projects submitted to the 2011-2012 SCORE Program must be completed by July 31, 2012 to allow time for post-installation inspections.*

TO PARTICIPATE IN THE SCORE PROGRAM, YOU WILL NEED TO UNDERSTAND AND AGREE TO THESE TERMS:

Participant will identify a contact person to work with the Program throughout the term of the Partnership to identify and assess natural gas efficiency measures and implement efficient operations & maintenance practices identified during walk-through assessments.

The SCORE Pilot Program will pay Participant monetary incentives for eligible energy efficiency savings achieved by projects completed no later than **7/31/2012**.

Participant will make its best effort to complete and submit relevant Project Application Forms, including necessary supporting documentation for each project, in a timely manner.

The Project Application process is required in order to reserve financial incentives for your projects.

Participant acknowledges that without monetary incentives and other services from the SCORE Pilot Program, projects completed through the program would not have been accomplished (or would have been completed with less efficient equipment).

Participant will allow the SCORE Pilot Program to use Participant's name to promote participation in the Program to entities such as potential program Participants, utilities, federal, state, or local entities, and the general public.

Acceptance of Agreement

By endorsing below, your organization accepts this agreement with the SCORE Program, sponsored by New Mexico Gas Company.
