Background and Summary:

This is the annual renewal of the Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) between the Peak Behavioral Health Services (Peak) and the Gadsden Independent School District (GISD). Because the Peak is located within the geographical boundaries of the GISD, the District is required to provide educational services to school-age students residing there, which includes both general education and special education students. The District is currently providing 3 teachers and 2 instructional aides and core academic classes to a maximum of 48 students (general education and/or special education). In addition, the District provides three portables (one double and two singles) on the Peak site for instructional purposes, as well as instructional supplies and materials. The District receives state and federal funding for students residing at the Peak in the same manner as it does for all students residing in the district.
