The purpose of this letter is to inform you that the NMPED is releasing a redistribution to *High Schools That Work* (HSTW) sites. - 3) to support Career-Technical Education Programs in New Mexico.

To access these funds, a completed application (attached) must be received in the College and Career Readiness (CCR) office by March 15, 2012. The Application is also located on the New Mexico Public Education Department (NMPED), Career-Technical and Workforce Education Bureau website at:



The expectations from the U.S. Department of Education are that the funds will be expended by September 30, 2012. All funds must be requested for reimbursement from the PED by October 26, 2012. The timelines stated in the application have been adjusted to meet this report deadline.

Please remember that no reimbursement from the redistribution funds can be made for any expenditure prior to the date you receive notice of an approved application and budget. You are encouraged to apply for these funds as soon as possible so that you may complete your project objectives within the required time lines.
