TO: SOAP Managers, STARS Coordinators, QES Administrators

The Quality of Education Survey (QES) for 2014 is opening.

Your designated representative must review the optional questions for retention, update, or deletion within the next two weeks.

As required by state statute (NMSA 22-2C-11 D.) the PED specifies the first ten questions, while districts and schools may add up to five additional questions each. The survey portal is available online at the PED website (*A to Z Directory, Quality of Education Survey*). The survey has been pre-populated with questions from the prior year.

Please Note

Transfer of data to NMPED by way of spreadsheet or other non-web based mechanism is <u>no longer allowed</u>. Bulk data entry will be available to school officials who wish to enter aggregate figures into the online system.

Locally-authorized charter schools must work with their parent district for access to the survey system. State-authorized charter schools must authorize staff to be accountable for all QES functions. Log-in credentials have not changed from prior years. After the initial login, your main QES site administrator may add additional logins for support staff. If you were given a password/login from your local administrator and need assistance, you should contact your local site administrator before contacting the PED.
