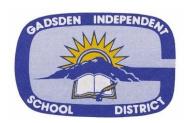

- A. Steve Suggs, CFO, gave the Board an overview of the Monthly Budget Report for the Month Ended May 31, 2014.
- B. Mr. Giron explained setting up a plan for course articulation on specified courses and instructional programs between Dona Ana Community College and Gadsden. The articulated courses will be

indicated on the students' transcript and will facilitate the student getting credit for the course when enrolled at DACC. C. Deputy Superintendent Suggs explained the need to amend Policy IKEB, Acceleration, to include subject-based acceleration and clarify that acceleration is a decision made by a student assistance Amend Policy IKEB team (SAT). Resolution IKEB-R, Acceleration (Subject-based Acceleration Acceleration in Middle School), clarifies that middle school subject-based acceleration may include Algebra I, Spanish I and II, Geometry, and English I. D. Mr. Gallegos explained that the Riverside parking lot was Resolution with complete and that a resolution with NM DOT needs to be **NMDOT** submitted for reimbursement. E. Deputy Superintendent Suggs informed the Board that the 2015 Graduations dates would be Thursday, May 21, 2015 at 6:30 p.m. 2015 Graduation at the Pan Am Center for Gadsden High School and Saturday, May Dates 23, 2015 the Don Haskins Center, Chaparral High School at 10:00 a.m. and Santa Teresa High School at 2:00 p.m. 10. Closed Session: Mr. Ford made the motion to go into Closed Session pursuant to 10-15-1, H-2, NMSA 1978 for Superintendent's and Associate Superintendent's report on recent personnel actions and issues such as: employees on administrative leave with pay, employee Closed Session grievances, and pending or potential litigation/attorney-client communication. Deputy Superintendent Suggs recommended approval of the motion. Motion carried unanimously. The Board went into Closed Session at 5:51 p.m. 11. Ms. Saenz made a motion to reconvene in open session. No action was taken. Deputy Superintendent Suggs recommended approval of Reconvene the motion. Motion carried unanimously. The Board reconvened in Open Session at 7:03 p.m. Adjourn 12. Ms. Irigoyen made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Deputy Superintendent Suggs recommended approval of the motion. Motion carried unanimously. The meeting adjourned at 7:04 p.m.
