The details of the project must be agreed to mutually in writing between the District and the PSFA through MOUs, which shall be executed following acceptance of the award by the District. The signed MOU shall be returned to your PSFA Regional Manager no later than November 17, 2017.

In addition to project specific contingencies or other requirements specified in the award language, additional conditions were adopted by the PSCOC (see attached).
