## DO NOT RESUSCITATE ORDERS

Board of Education Policy JLCG, Do Not Resuscitate (DNR) Orders, will be fully explained to parents who present DNR orders. A school official shall meet with the parent and physician to determine the child's medical diagnosis, current condition, prognosis and anticipated medical needs. School personnel shall then convene a multidisciplinary team meeting to develop a health management plan for the student, which may include a medical resuscitation plan, and individually appropriate life-sustaining interventions to be followed in a medical emergency. If the parent declines to meet or to agree to a health management plan, this shall be noted in the student's file.

School health personnel and other school personnel who have been trained in emergency rescue procedures (cardiopulmonary resuscitation [CPR]) are expected to administer first aid, including life-saving or resuscitation procedures, to a student in the event of an accident, choking, respiratory and/or cardiac arrest, or other life-threatening emergency.

<u>Community emergency response personnel (911) will be called immediately and school personnel will continue resuscitation procedures until they are relieved by emergency response personnel.</u>

Once transport of the student from the school to an emergency room or medical facility by emergency response personnel begins, DNR orders shall become the responsibility of parents and physicians.
