

The classes students could choose from are: Chess, Financial Planning, Calligraphy, Field Day, Crochet, BPA/Innoventure Challenge, and Film Classics. David stated that for his enrichment elective class, he chose the BPA/Innoventure Challenge. In this class, student teams are tasked in designing a product based on the competitions theme where the teams will build, market and sell the product. The building of the product will give me the opportunity to help towards his future educational goals in engineering. They will continue to be enrolled in the state test prep class in the spring semester and students will be able to choose new enrichment elective classes in the spring semester. Alta Vista Early College students are excited to continue the school clubs and organizations they had last year such as yearbook, science club, and chess club.
