Rates and Payment Provisions** The Vendor hereby agrees to furnish meals (inclusive/exclusive) of milk to the Center for the rates listed below: Breakfast \$ 0.00 Lunch \$ 0.00 each Supper \$ 0.00 each Snack **\$ 0.62** each Approximately 40 meals will be required for each day of service. A monthly bill for the total number of meals ordered and received will be sent by the Vendor to the Center by the of each month. Payment is due to the vendor last working day of the month [In accordance with CFR 226.6 (i) (7)] Payment shall not be made to the vendor for; meals which are delivered outside of the agreed upon delivery time, meals which are spoiled or unwholesome at the time of delivery or do not otherwise meet the meal specification requirements contained in the contract. III. Specifications [In accordance with CFR 226.6 (i) (6)] The vendor shall operate in accordance with current USDA Child and Adult Care Food Program regulations. [In accordance with CFR 226.6 (i) (4)] Meals delivered shall conform to a Cycle Menu (Please Attach copy) upon which the bid was based and to menu changes agreed upon in writing by both the center and the vendor. [In accordance with CFR 226.6 (i) (10)] All meals and snacks must conform to the State of New Mexico and the USDA Child and Adult Care Food Program requirements of CFR 226.20 and in nutritive value and content, required components and minimum quantities as specified in Attachment B (Meal pattern requirements/ creditable foods).

[In accordance with CFR 226.6 (i) (3)]

All meals and snacks must be prepared in a kitchen operating with a current passing certification inspection (Please Attach copy) from the State of New Mexico Environmental Department or have other local or Federal health certification. Health and sanitation conditions are to be met by the vendor at all times. All meals and snacks must be prepared under sanitary conditions and held, as well as delivered to the Center at proper temperatures to prevent food borne illness. Meals are to be made available upon request to New Mexico CYFD/FNB state agency staff for periodic inspection by the local heath department or an independent agency to determine if bacteria levels conform to the levels which may be present in meals prepared or served by other establishments in the locality. The results of these inspections shall be submitted to the center and the state agency.

All main meals delivered for out-side school hours care centers shall be unitized with or without milk, unless an exemption is granted by the state agency. For other facilities the state agency may require unitization if there is evidence which indicates that it is necessary to insure compliance with CFR 226.20
