#### Tutoring and Mentoring

Tutoring and Mentoring Detailed Description: We will use classroom teachers, as well as high school Teacher Cadets from GHS, for basic skills tutoring incorporating the Skills Tutor program. Special emphasis will be given to math, science and language arts, but skill enhancement will be available for all areas. We will identify students not enrolled in Ramp Up or Read 180 programs that are also still below proficiency, and we will also use EXPLORE results to determine need for tutoring. In addition, teachers will also recommend students, especially those who are not involved in extra-curricular activities. Attempt will be made to limit student/teacher ratio to no more than 5:1. Approximately 50 students will attend. The period of time for each class will depend on the needs of the students. Tutoring will take place twice a week after school from 4pm -6pm so that the students will be able to go home on the activity buses provided by the school.
