Dear Ms. Nava:

The FY10 district/charter school award allocation process for the **Mentoring Program for Beginning Teachers**, as administered by the **Educator Quality Division** of the New Mexico Public Education Department, has begun. Based on Senate Bill 146, the initial award being made to your district/charter school represents fifty percent of your estimated award and will be disbursed prior to (September 15 of the fiscal year.) The balance of the award, which is based on the 40<sup>th</sup> Day STARS report and will reconcile any differences between the initial estimate and the final new teacher count, will be completed prior to January 15<sup>th</sup> annually.

Therefore, the award for 40 beginning teachers receiving mentorship services at fifty percent is **\$21,742**. Funding under this award must be used as specified by supporting legislation, the mentorship regulation (6.60.10 NMAC) and in alignment with the district's/charter's mentorship program plan. These funds will be distributed and must be expended in accordance with the legislative language.

1. Please submit an electronic Budget Adjustment Request (BAR) utilizing Fund Code: 27154, Revenue Code: 43202 in the **Operating Budget Management System (OBMS)**. This award letter must be attached electronically to the BAR.
2. Quarterly expenditure reports are required via OBMS.
