
**CONTRACTED CAREER AND TECHNICAL EDUCATION
ANNUAL AGREEMENT
2010 - 2011**

This agreement, entered on the **16th** day of **August, 2010**, between the El Paso Independent School District (EPISD) and **Gadsden Independent School District**(GISD) is for the purpose of providing Career and Technical Education instruction at The Center for Career and Technology Education (**CCTE**), 1170 Walnut Street, El Paso, Texas and The Occupational Center (**OCC**), 5300 Warriors, El Paso, Texas. This agreement shall be in effect **August 23, 2010 to June 3, 2011**.

This agreement is to be conducted in accordance with local and state guidelines for Career and Technical Education. The El Paso Independent School District (EPISD) will bill **Gadsden Independent School District** (GISD) at the end of this agreement at the rate of \$1,200.00 per student per year for a half-day program. Your district will be billed at the end of the contract year by **May, 2011**. The El Paso Independent School District (EPISD) will provide contact hour reports to Gadsden Independent School District (GISD) on the attendance of the contracted students in order for Gadsden Independent School District (GISD) to receive career and technical education weighted funding. The El Paso Independent School District (EPISD) will not be responsible for bus transportation to and from the Center for Career and Technology Education (CCTE) or the Occupational Center (OCC).


Conditions to this agreement include:

1. Students will abide by EPISD's Student Code of Conduct.
2. Students from Outlying Districts will only be permitted to enroll in Programs of Study (POS) that do not exist within their home district or home campus.
3. Outlying Districts will purchase slots for student enrollment according to the number of students attending CCTE and OCC by **September 1st, 2010**. If a student withdraws from CCTE / OCC, the tuition will **not** be pro-rated.
4. Outlying Districts will be informed of the POS's that are closed due to high enrollment from EPISD campuses.
5. Outlying Districts will provide a copy of all elements required for registration to include:
 - IEP / 504 / Behavior Intervention Plan,
 - Accommodations and Modifications,
 - Texas Achievement Plan (4-Year Plan) and
 - Emergency Card.
6. Students from Outlying Districts (**Texas Residents Only**) who are interested in Dual Credit from El Paso Community College (EPCC) must submit the following items to CCTE prior to June 15:
 - District / Campus Transcript,
 - TAKS Results or Minimum required score (Reading score of 78) on ACCUPLACER, and
 - EPCC ID Number - *Complete EPCC Application for enrollment online.*
