Background and Summary:

BAR is to ratify changes in function code to initial BAR presented at the October 25, 2012 Board Meeting to accommodate final award letter.

BAR request for 21st Century Community Learning Center (21<sup>ST</sup> CCLC) AWARD to Chaparral, Mesquite, Riverside Elem and Chaparral Middle School. 21st CCLC goals are: To increase the participating student's knowledge and confidence in the STEM (science, technology, engineering, mathematics) subjects, reading, language arts, communication skills, and other integrated topics; To provide a safe, nurturing, and high quality after school learning environment; To increase the knowledge base and participation of the families of the participating students; To increase the knowledge base of instructors as well as understanding and implementing successful teaching strategies that meets the needs of all students; To form a strong collaborative educational network that will continue in the future each program will offer 38 sessions so that each student can be counted. Monday through Friday, Chaparral Middle School CLC will operate from 3:45 – 6:00 p.m.; Chaparral Elementary 2:30 – 5:00 p.m.; Riverside Elementary 3:00 – 5:00 p.m.; and Mesquite Elementary 2:30 – 5:00 p.m. In addition to the afterschool sessions, there will be field trips to the NMSU Campus, the Aerospace Education



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Laboratory, Family Festivals, and the Science/Math Brain Battle field trips. Summer camps will also be included to meet the needs of the students who participated in the after school programs throughout the academic year; encompassing the four content areas (math, literacy, science and technology) with physical activities that highlight the need for physical movement.
