## Adequate Funding for School Transportation

## Resolution

WHEREAS, the Gadsden Independent School District consists of 26 educational facilities educating the children of Southern Dona Ana County and Southern Otero County; and

WHEREAS, the Gadsden Independent School District educates approximately 14,000 students in programs stretching from pre-school through $12^{\text {th }}$ grade; and

WHEREAS, the Gadsden Independent School District covers an area of 1400 square miles; and
WHEREAS, approximately $77 \%$ of the 14,000 students are transported annually; and
WHEREAS, approximately One Million Nine Hundred Thousand miles are traveled each year to transport these students; and

WHEREAS, the Public Education Department created a shortfall of \$600,000 in transportation budget for the 2015-16 school year; and

WHEREAS, the Gadsden Independent School District was in the top five that lost funding; and
WHEREAS, the $\$ 600,000$ shortfall has created a hardship for the district to adequately serve students of Gadsden Independent School District for the 2015-16 school year; and

WHEREAS, after school activities, such as athletic events, tutoring sessions, and enrichment programs have been curtailed to the detriment of student participation; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE GADSDEN INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT AND BOARD OF EDUCATION call upon the New Mexico Public Education Department to re-instate the transportation funding that was awarded the district in the 2014-15 school year; and
