## Synopsis of the Title I Part C (Migrant) Program for 2017-18

## Gadsden Independent School District School Board Meeting May 25, 2017

The **Title I Part C** award for 2017-18 is \$75,753. As you know, this budget provides supplies and services to eligible migrant students and their families.

In SY 17-18, the Migrant budget will continue to provide professional support for Migrant students and their families through the liaison services of our Migrant Mentors. In addition the award will support stipends for after school tutoring for Priority of Service Migrant students in reading and math. The following supports are provided on a priority needs basis:

- Stipends for student/family mentor services designed to help students and families bridge the gap that may exist between the home and school.
- School supplies and uniforms for migrant students, if needed.
- Professional development for staff members who serve migrant families to bring providers to a
  deeper understanding of the migrant culture and any barriers that may prevent student success in
  school.

I am respectfully requesting authorization for the Superintendent or his designee to sign and submit the Title I Part C (Migrant) application to the New Mexico Public Education Department upon completion.
