

SABBATICAL LEAVE

Upon approval as a part of a compensation plan the Board may grant sabbatical leave to licensed teaching and administrative personnel for a maximum of one (1) year in accordance with 22-10A-2(I), 22-10A-35 through 22-10A-38 NMSA 1978, and 6.66.4.8 NMAC.

“Sabbatical leave” means leave of absence with pay as approved by the governing authority during all or part of a regular school term for the purposes of study or travel related to a licensed school employee’s duties and of direct benefit to the instructional program.
