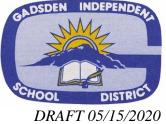

REGULAR SCHOOL BOARD MINUTES

For May 7, 2020

- 1. The Gadsden School Board convened in regular session at 5:01 p.m. President Viramontes presided at the meeting held at the Gadsden Administrative Complex. Introduction And Roll Call Members present: Armando Cano, Daniel Castillo, Laura Salazar Flores, Claudia Rodriguez, and Jennifer Viramontes. 2. The Pledge of Allegiance and the Pledge to the New Mexico Flag was recited. Daniel Castillo read the mission statement.
 - 3. Superintendent: District Updates and Recognitions:
 - A. Superintendent Dempsey presented information on the Update on Annual Recognition of Retiring Employees. He said the event is really well attended and perhaps we could look into a larger location in the future. The event will be postponed until August.
 - B. Superintendent Dempsey presented information on the Update on Gadsden ISD Graduation Ceremonies. He noted that discussions concerning options are ongoing. Traditionally, graduations have been held at the UTEP Don Haskins Center. He mentioned hosting graduations at the UTEP Sun Bowl, however, due to construction it would not be available for July 18, 2020. Other options would be hosting graduation at each high school football stadium in the evening. Mr. Cano suggested contacting Southwest University Park to host graduations.
 - C. Superintendent Dempsey presented information on the Update On Planning For 2020-2021 School Year. He reported that the Reopening Committee is drafting 3 possible options for the start of the 2020-21 school year. Plan A is 100% Remote Learning, Plan B is a blended model that includes both face to face instruction along with Remote Learning and Plan C is a normal face to face return. Also, Superintendent Dempsey stated the subcommittees includes district expectations, schedules, curriculum & instruction for Pre-K, elementary, middle and high school, SPED/504, Bilingual needs, interventions, professional development, technology committee, wellness and safety,
