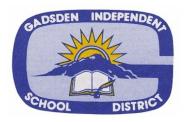

For July 22, 2021

1. The Gadsden School Board convened in regular session at 5:02 p.m. President Salazar Flores presided at the meeting held at the Gadsden Administrative Complex.
