Mitigation efforts are the COVID safe practices implemented at the campus level to reduce the possible spread of the COVID virus.

0%-1%	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Mask wearing is required in all indoor spaces following the guidelines established in the NMPED Toolkit ● Implement and encourage hand hygiene ● Implement and encourage respiratory etiquette ● Implement and encourage distancing per NMPED Toolkit (Greatest Extent Possible) ● Offer student COVID testing at area High Schools weekly ● Require 100% of unvaccinated staff to take a weekly COVID test ● Isolation Rooms for students/staff presenting with COVID symptoms ● Parents are asked to complete an in home health screening with their child prior to arrival at school. Students who are ill are required to remain at home and notify the school. ● Students arriving to the campus with COVID related symptoms will not be permitted to remain on campus. Parent(s)/ guardian(s) will be notified and asked to pick up their child from the school. Student(s) will be placed, under adult supervision, in the school isolation room. ● Students living in the same household with an individual who has tested (+) positive for COVID will be asked to remain at home for the recommended quarantine period. ● Parents are requested to notify the school when a member of their household is ill with COVID symptoms or has tested (+) for COVID ● Students who are quarantined, their absences will be considered

	<p>excused, and the student will be able to keep up with their school work via the google classrooms.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● School nurses will consult with families and teachers regarding illness or COVID related concerns ● Staff are required to submit a Daily Health Screening prior to arrival at the school campus ● Staff who meet the following must complete the GISD Employee Self Reporting form: 1) are ill; 2) are testing for COVID; 3) have a household member who is ill with COVID like symptoms; 4) has a household member testing for COVID or is (+) for COVID. The employee may not return to the school campus or district building until cleared by a GISD Contact Tracing Nurse. ● Notes from a Health Care Provider clearing a student or staff member to return to school with COVID related symptoms will not be accepted. (Symptoms such as: cough, congestion, runny nose, sore throat, body aches, temperature) ● Teacher reinforcement of COVID safe practices ● Offer student COVID testing ● Classroom Seating Charts required ● Parents will be notified of a Positive COVID case on campus ● Daily disinfecting routines followed with emphasis on restrooms & high touch surfaces ● Regular use of electrostatic sprayers to disinfect learning spaces ● Air purifiers in use in all learning spaces (MERV 16 rating) ● Continuation of COVID vaccinations for eligible students and staff ● Developed plan of learning for remote instruction as needed by students (Google Classroom) ● Large group gatherings masked indoor events with outside contingency plan ● Extra-Curricular will follow NMAA Guidelines <p>*** Minimum requirements.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">2%</p>	<p>Maintain all COVID safe practices from previous category and add:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Reinforce and maintain hand washing ● Reinforce and maintain respiratory etiquette ● Scheduled handwashing breaks (elementary) ● Washing or sanitizing of hands when leaving and entering a classroom for all students and staff ● Reinforce and maintain social distancing per toolkit (Greatest Extent Possible) ● Table shields in cafeteria or approved alternate seating (such as facing one direction, outside eating areas) ● Nursing & Central Office Administrative discretion using the GISD

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> contact tracing protocols (classroom or wing closures) ● Continuation of COVID vaccinations for eligible students and staff ● Large Group Gatherings: Limited to outside events only ● Students will wipe the desk surface: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Elementary level prior to lunch and at the end of the day. ○ Secondary level at the end of each class.
3%	<p>Maintain all COVID safe practices from previous category and add:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Encourage distancing per toolkit (3 feet) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Revisit cafeteria schedules ○ Staggering lunches / schedules ○ Alternative eating spaces (outside) ● District Administrators/ Nursing department discretion using the GISD contact tracing protocols (classroom or wing closures) ● Desk shields required in classrooms ● 1 day remote learning with campus wide disinfecting ● HVAC systems set to increase percent of fresh air intake (where systems allow) ● Large Group Gathering: Outside only with masks ● Continuation of COVID vaccinations for eligible students and staff
4%	<p>Maintain all COVID safe practices from previous category and add:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Masking: Required in ALL spaces ● Take a short term (2 day closure) to follow up with contact tracing and campus wide disinfection ● All staff will work on campus maintaining 6 ft or greater distance. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ No indoor staff/group meetings or shared eating spaces ● Random COVID testing of all staff (vaccinated and unvaccinated) ● Special Education students will continue to receive education and services on the school campus ● Large Group Gatherings: Essential Events Only (Graduation Ceremony)
5%	<p>Maintain all COVID safe practices from previous category and add:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Closure of an individual campus will be considered by GISD administration for students only (10 day) ● All staff will continue to work on campus maintaining 6 ft or greater distance. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ No indoor staff/group meetings or shared eating spaces ● Special Education students will continue to receive education and services on the school campus ● Establish Hybrid Learning
