# Instructional Materials Adoption: Social Studies Core Material

## School Board Policy IJJ - TEXTBOOK / SUPPLEMENTARY MATERIALS SELECTION AND ADOPTION

- The Board will approve the budget for the purchase of new textbooks and supplementary books.
- The Superintendent shall establish textbook selection procedures that shall provide for the appropriate involvement of staff members, students, and community members.
- Written notice to parents and other community members will be provided and parents will be involved in the instructional materials adoption process.
- Public notice regarding the instructional materials adoption process will be provided.
- The textbook and supplementary materials selection process must include a review of options available on the multiple lists provided for in Section 22-15-8 of the New Mexico Statutes Annotated.
- The procedures established may provide for textbook selection committees.
- Recommendations from such textbook selection committees will be forwarded to the Superintendent.




- Notice to parents and public was provided on the GISD Website

- Campuses committees reviewed each title and submitted a rubric





### Instructional Materials Adoption: Continued

#### SAVVAS and McGraw Hill offer the only near comprehensive K-12 programs.

#### **Both**

- Have digital access to online material and text.
- Have compatibility with Google Classroom and Schoology (LMS)
- Have supplemental materials and tools to support ELs and SPED Students

#### **SAVVAS**

- Identical spanish/english material K-5, 6, 8, translation tools in 9-12 digital texts
- K-5 student text are write in consumables, 8-12 traditional student texts
- K-5 Leveled Readers (English/Spanish)
- 9-12 Primary Source/Reading guide (consumable)
- Copyright Dates K-5, 6, 8 (2019) 9-12 (2022, 2023)

#### **McGraw Hill**

- Identical spanish/english material K-5,
  - Student Edition, Student Inquiry Journal, Explorer Magazine, Research Companion in Spanish/English
- 6 and 8 12 student editions in Spanish
- Did not submit Government/Economics as the 2024 Edition was not published.
- Copyright Dates K-5 (2020) 6, 8, 9-12 (2023)

## Instructional Materials Adoption: Next Steps

- Work with finance, technology, and follow up with campuses to make final decision.
  - What is the experience with current adoptions from SAVVAS and McGraw Hill?
    - Students, teachers and technology
  - What is offered as part of the package from publishers and cost?
- Follow up with publishers on details regarding availability of material
- NM History No core material and minimal supplemental material available
  - Focus on finding resources to support 4th and 7th grade students.
  - Pause on 9th grade material until new graduation requirements are place in rule by NMPED.
- Supplemental material Sociology, Psychology, AP
  - To be selected after core material process is completed.

- Free Filtered Internet is available for families with students enrolled in GISD
- Reduced Rate Internet is available for families who qualify (up to \$30 per month rate reduction)
