REGULATION ASSIGNMENT OF STUDENTS TO CLASSES AND GRADE LEVELS

Maximum Age for Enrollment at Comprehensive High Schools and Early College High School

Students turning nineteen years old prior to the start of the school year will be enrolled in, or transferred, to Desert Pride Academy. Students served under Individuals with Disabilities Education Act or the McKinney-Vento Homeless Assistance Act can remain at the comprehensive high school or early college as provisions of those programs. If a student is granted an extra year of eligibility, beyond the age of nineteen, by the New Mexico Activities Association, for participation in athletics and activities, they will be exempt from this regulation for that year.
